LEVELS

& WHAT THEY MEAN FOR YOU

ENTRY LEVEL

Entry level is for those with no formal qualifications, taking the first step into a chosen area

Equivalent to GCSE (Grades D-G)
This is the first step into a vocational subject. This teaches essential knowledge of your chosen field

LEVEL 1

LEVEL 2

Equivalent to GCSE (Grades A*-C) and NVQ Level 2. This allows you to progress into further education and training

Equivalent at AS/A Levels, BTEC and a higher qualification to prepare you in your chosen career

LEVEL 3

LEVEL 4+

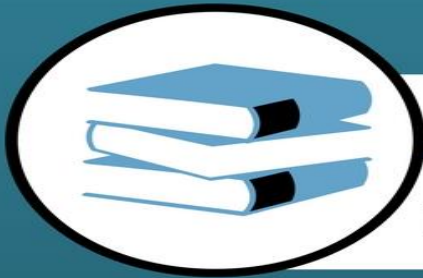
Many people go on to complete Level 4+ and have qualifications equivalent to a degree. A short, less studios approach to university.

QUALIFICATIONS & WHAT THEY MEAN FOR YOU



A/AS LEVELS

These are LEVEL 3 qualifications. These require you to be a full-time student studying between 1-2 years. You can study up to four subjects.

VOCATIONAL

These are a work related qualification. They give you experience to work in a work setting, giving you the skills and knowledge needed.



APPRENTICESHIPS

These are jobs with training and studying that lead to a recognised qualifications. There are different levels of apprenticeships that take up to 1-4 years to complete.

FUNCTIONAL

College gives you the opportunity to re-sit GCSE's. Alongside your re-sits (usually Math or English) you will study Functional Skills.

The Fairbridge Programme is a **FREE** Personal Development Programme for young people aged 16 – 25 who are currently unemployed or who lack the skills or confidence to engage in full time training or education

The next Portsmouth Fairbridge Programmes at the **Highbury Arundel Centre, Arundel Street, Portsmouth, PO1 1SA** will be starting **30th April 2018**

ACCESS – Is an introductory week where the young people will take part in activities such as climbing, raft-building and a two night residential. Young People also have the opportunity to achieve the Prince's Trust Personal Development and Employability skills qualification

FOLLOW-ON – is an individually tailored journey where young people pick and choose the sessions they want to attend. What kind of activities do we offer?

- Kayaking
- Mountain Biking
- Budgeting and employability sessions
- Bush craft and outdoor cooking sessions
- Conservation and community projects

1:1 SUPPORT – Throughout the programme Young People will be supported by a dedicated worker who will help them set goals and work with them to develop the skills to help them move towards a positive outcome

IN ADDITION - Young People will have the opportunity to build their skills base, developing their numeracy and literacy with the support of specialist staff

MOVING ON – When the time is right for the young people to leave the programme they are supported into positive outcomes and will received 3 months of follow up support from their dedicated worker

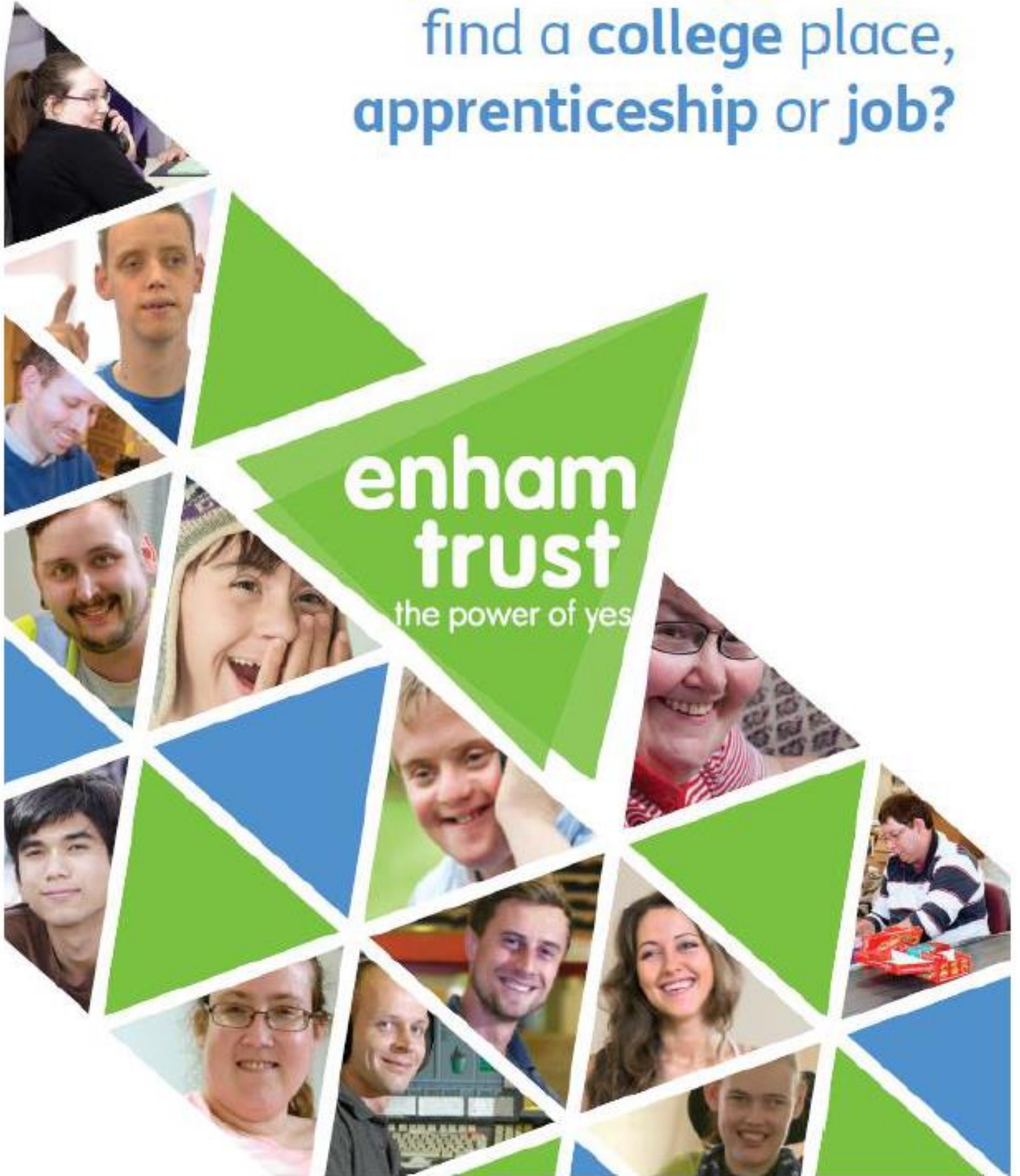
