#### **Sunday 16**th **September** – Street Dance Workshop



We aim to make the majority of our events wheelchair accessible and cost effective but this is not always possible all of the time.





Portsmouth Youth Project is run by Enable Ability and is for young people aged between 17.5 – 25 years living in Portsmouth with a physical and/or mild-moderate learning disability, or additional special educational need.

The Project aims to provide young people with the opportunity to engage in a variety of planned recreational, social and sporting activities as well as supported volunteering and work experience, as part of a group setting. This enables young people to interact and socialise with other peers on a regular basis. Activities are designed to improve pivotal life skills for all young people; including building their confidence & self-esteem, independence, communications and multitasking skills, to name a few.

Portsmouth Youth Project staff are trained and qualified to support young people and accommodate their needs during each activity, regardless of their level of ability, physical or otherwise. Activities for the Project include social clubs, going to the cinema, general socialising, plus supported volunteering and work experience. We also arrange a variety of day trips outside of the local area to museums, theatres or theme parks.

Once a referral to our Project has been made – this can be by a parent, the young person themselves or a professional – we arrange a Home Visit to meet the family and have a chat about our Project and what we can offer.

A mini bus service is also provided to accommodate for <u>long distance trips</u>. Most activities for the Project take place on a Saturday afternoon.

There is no obligation to attend all activities; parents and carers are free to register their son/daughter for as many activities as they please
